


LOCAL LANDMARK



FICOFOLIA AVENUE

Ficofolia Avenue stands as a testament to Drouin's natural beauty and community spirit. Lined with centuryold gum trees, the avenue of trees is located on either side of the main road into Drouin, painting a picturesque scene of a blooming scarlet canopy above the town. The annual Ficofolia Festival and Parade celebrates the flowering of these gums, and the town's dedication to preserving its heritage and treasured green spaces for more than 32 years. The community festival brings the entire town together with family entertainment, activities, markets, fireworks, and a warm sense of togetherness that pays homage to the town's history.








Whether it's privacy or the drive to form bonds, Altura will enrich the lives of all those who call it home.
